- summary: Arial Narrow, italic, 9, left, 100-150 words:
- key words: 4-6, Arial Narrow, italic, 9, left;
- text: Arial Narrow, size 11, line space: single, justified, two columns text;
- page setup: top 1 inch; bottom 1 inch; inside 1 inch; outside 0.7 inch; size A4; maximum 6 pages.

The papers will be written in **English***. The accepted papers will be included in the journals *Knowledge Horizons Economics*, *World Economy Journal*, *Global Economic Observer* quoted BDI.
